Status Code

C 5 L 11 translates to chapter 5 Laws of 2011 Regular Session. Bills passed during a special session will look like "C 2 L 11 E1" the E1 standing for 1st special session. "Del to gov" means delivered to the governor for signature. She has 20 days from sine die (end of session) not including Sundays to sign it or it becomes law without her signature. Eventually the status will change to "gov signed," then a chapter law designation will be identified once the process is finished. "S filed Sec/St" means filed with the secretary of state. Joint memorials do not require the governor's signature because they are a message from the legislature to the feds named in the memorial. The final step of assigning RCW IDs will be done by the Code Reviser's office but those won't ever show upon the report. Once that work is done, you can find where a section of law is codified by using the cross-reference table on the legislative site.
