DIRECTIONS TO Margaret McKenny Campground:

From the North

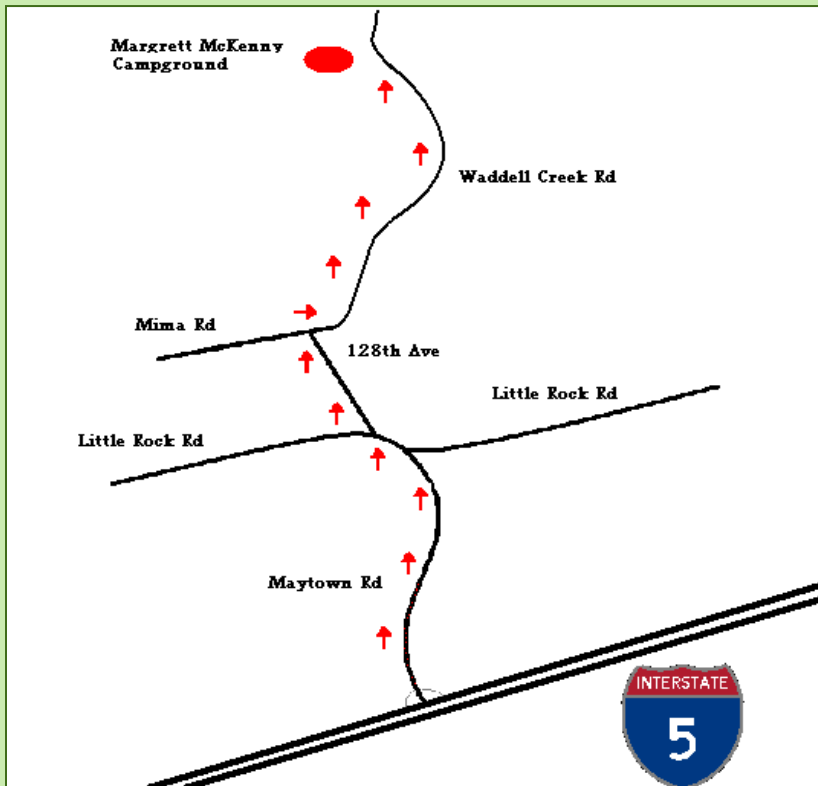
From US 101 take the Black Lake/Capitol Mall Exit and head south.

Follow Black Lake Blvd 4.3 miles until it comes to a "T" with Delphi Rd.

Take a left and go 2.2 miles until you come to Waddell Creek Rd.

Take a right on Waddell Creek Rd. and follow it for 2.8 miles till you come to Margaret McKenny Campground

Drive through and look for parking instructions



From the South

Leave Interstate 5, at Exit #95

From this exit head west, on the Maytown Rd. for approximately 3 miles

At Littlerock, this road becomes 128th Ave. Continue about a mile until the road ends at the "T" of the Waddell Creek Rd. and Mima Rd. intersections.

Turn Right onto Waddell Creek Rd. /Mima Rd. Continue on this road for 2.5 miles entrance to campground will be on left. Drive through and look for parking instructions
